How many times is it mentioned?
<p>2d</p> <p>Think about it</p> <p>make inferences from the text / explain and justify inferences with evidence from the text</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• What makes you think that?• Which words give you that impression?• How do you feel about...?• Can you explain why...?• What do these words mean and why do you think the author chose them?
<p>2e</p> <p>Predict it</p> <p>predict what might happen from details stated and implied</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Can you think of another story, which has a similar theme; e.g. good over evil; weak over strong; wise over foolish? Do you think this story will go the same way?• Which stories have openings like this? Do you think this story will develop in the same way?• Why did the author choose this setting? Will that influence how the story develops?

<p style="text-align: center;">2f</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Connect it</p> <p style="text-align: center;">identify / explain how information / narrative content is related and contributes to meaning as a whole</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Explain why a character did something. • Explain a character's different/changing feelings throughout a story. How do you know? • What are the clues that a character is liked/disliked/envied/feared/loved/hated etc...? • Why is 'x' (character/setting/event) important in the story? • What is the story (theme) underneath the story? Does this story have a moral or a message? • Why has the writer written/organised the text in this way?

'x'? • Which words do you think are most important? Why? • Find two or three ways that the writer tells you 'x'. • Has the writer been successful in their purpose or use of language? • What other words/phrases could the author have used?
