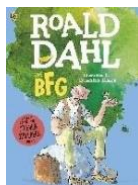


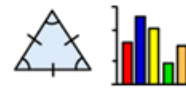
English / Reading / Phonics

In English and reading this term we will be focusing on the texts *The world came to my place today* by Jo Readman, *A ticket around the world* by Melissa Owens and Natalia Diaz, *BFG* by Roald Dahl and *Ug* by Raymond Briggs. In English lessons, children will be focusing on poetry, a narrative and finally an information report about food.

Reading lessons are based on the 8 areas of reading including inference, retrieval and comparison.
